REPORT ON GOSPEL OUTREACH AND AIDS EDUCATION IN THE REGION OF KASESE (Western Uganda)

We are so thankful to the Lord for giving us the opportunity to hold meetings in Bundibugyo, Kasese, Rukungiri and Mpondwe (Western Uganda) in recent times.

We used this opportunity to preach the gospel and give AIDS-education. We were able to do this for the

women and girls who attended the Bible conferences in Bundibugyo, Kasese and Mpondwe. In the village of Rukungiri it was not possible this time due to special circumstances.

After the Bible studies, which were given by brothers, the girls had the opportunity, in a special meeting for them, to ask us, the three sisters below, practical questions on the subject of "sin".

This was one of the topics of the Bible studies in Bundibugyo, Mpondwe and Kasese. These had already been well explained by the

brothers. We only clarified what these girls had not understood regarding the special circumstances in which they live in the society (village, town, school) in Western Uganda.

We had also planned to preach the gospel and give AIDS-education to some institutions that provide education after finishing secondary school in Kasese, such as Rwenzori College of Commerce, Liberty Collage and others. We will visit these institutions as soon as the opportunity arises.



During gospel outreach and Bible study for the sponsored children, we also had an opportunity to talk to the girls aged twelve and above about AIDS and moral behavior in society.

In both groups we studied Gal. 5:19-23 to give these women and girls examples of the fruit of

the Spirit and the works of the flesh. We related both the "fruit" and the "works" to the infection with AIDS.

At the beginning of this year, we also had the opportunity to share with six married women in Kabuyiri village the teaching from the Word of God in a very practical way, for example in the Bible passage Titus 2:1-5.

We also gave a short review of 1 Samuel 1 to emphasize prayer in times of trouble



through the special example of Anna, which speaks to us all so much.

God willing, we hope to visit some schools before the end of this month. We have already planned with them, and we are waiting for their response.
